

<p>Minutes of Trinity Primary PSA (TPSA) Meeting</p> <p>Venue: Zoom</p> <p>Date: 22nd February 2021 @ 7 pm</p>

<p>1. <u>Welcome & Update</u></p> <p>2. <u>Funds Update</u></p> <p>Totals in accounts £32,923</p> <p>Go Fund Me £1537</p> <p>We also have 7 new 50/50 Lotto club members, bringing the prize pot to £50ish.</p> <p>Improvements have been made to the Secret Garden (Mr Campbell has created a wooden shelter / outdoor classroom) and £2572 of PSA funds has been paid to school to partially fund this. Other funding came from a grant which the After School Club received.</p> <p>3. <u>School Needs</u></p> <p>The TPSA feel it is important that funds are spent on things which enhance pupil experience at school, particularly during lockdown and with the extra focus on outdoor learning.</p> <p>In addition to the funds already committed for the outdoor library, Mrs Scott has asked for funds for outdoor improvements / landscaping of the playground area – including new planters in time for Spring and artificial grass for the muddy mound which can be unusable at times.</p> <p>Provisionally the TPSA agree to £10k but this will be reviewed once quotes are received. Ideally work will be completed before the new school year in August.</p> <p>The outdoor library has been slightly delayed by lockdown but progress is being made. The After School Club shed has been relocated and school are waiting for quotes. Again, it is hoped that it will be completed before August.</p> <p>ACTION: Fiona to ask if any funds are needed to help with the new rabbits mentioned at the coffee morning.</p>
<p>4. <u>Fundraising</u></p> <p>Agreed to do another call out for new members for the 50/50 Lotto, EasyFundraising page and GoFundMe page. Discussion around whether or not to set a fundraising goal for the outdoor improvements or whether this is too off-putting / £10k too big an ask.</p> <p>Helena mentioned that two families have recently fundraised £400 for school within smaller fundraising ventures such as an online disco.</p>

ACTION: Fiona to ask how the fundraising goals were set previously for the major playground improvements.

ACTION: Tracy to look into EasyFundraising page to see if there is visibility of recent funds gained and donor numbers.
