AGENDA TOPICS:

1. School Updates from Mrs Scott:
 - Currently looking to fill 2 PSA roles.
 - Kirsty Martin leaves at the end of the term and will be a great loss to the school. Interviews for the post of Deputy Chair are ongoing.
 - This term has been challenging due to staff absences due to COVID, etc. Fortunately, the school has been able to remain open and the children haven't really been impacted.
 - Children enjoyed performing their MADD songs and dances outside. First time the whole school was outside together since lockdown.
 - Progress is being made on the Outdoor Library and Mound Maintenance. It's slow but still progressing. The school will pay for the work when it has been completed and the PSA will then reimburse them from our funds.
 - Due to the weather the school uniform sales haven't been able to go ahead.
