

In Scotland all children in Primary 1-5 get free meals in school, regardless of your family's circumstances.

However, if you are in receipt of any of these:

- · Income Support
- · Income-Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Universal Credit (monthly earning not more than £600)
 - Income-Based Employment and Support Allowance
- · Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, but not Working Tax Credit, and your income is less than £17,005

If you do match the conditions for free school meals, you will be eligible for:

- Free school meals
- · Payment for lunches during school holidays
 - Free milk
- A school clothing grant to help buy school clothes
 - · A Scottish Child Bridging Payment.
