AGENDA TOPICS:

1. Welcome. Particularly to the new faces - Catriona, Ella & Lindsay.
2. Fund requests
 - The front playground/mound is likely to need a fair amount spending to upgrade it up to meet the new safety standards plus general maintenance. It's a key part of school which all children benefit from.
The amount is TBC but could be hefty and we should reserve TPSA funds for this. The new bark alone was £6k - to be paid from school funds. School are also in conversation with the building company for repairs following the building work.
Other schools in Edinburgh, with similar playgrounds, are involved in the overall conversation & upcoming meeting.
