Sumdog



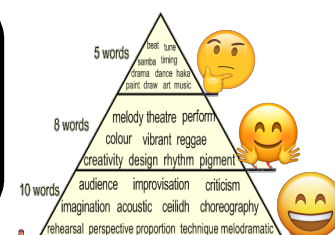
Challenge
